



COLONIAL SKATING CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, our club awards a scholarship to graduating seniors who are going on to college. We also grant continuing education scholarships to members who are in college and have continued their affiliation with the sport of figure skating.

To be eligible for the standard scholarship, a skater must have been a club member for a minimum of **one** year prior to graduating from high school. The skater must fill out the application and return it along with proof of acceptance/attendance from their college/university. The amount of the scholarship will be based on the number of consecutive years the skater has been a full member of the club and is actively skating or doing approved service work for the club, if unable to skate.

To be eligible for the continuing education scholarship, the skater must be actively involved in skating while attending college. The skater must be doing one of the following and must be able to provide the club with written documentation from their employer or coach:

1. Taking lessons on a regular basis from a coach.
2. Teaching skating on a regular basis at their college or nearby rink.
3. Participating as a member of a synchronized skating team.

The scholarship fund balance is based on the profits of the Stars and Stripes Competition. Therefore, the amount awarded is at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
